GOAL: To Increase the household income.

- Number of who were Unemployed and obtained a job. 83
- Number who have maintained the job for 90 days or more. 60
- Number who were employed upon entry in the program, and have increased their income 53
- Number who were assisted in Developing a resume. 120
- Number of job applications completed with assistance. 325
- Number who enrolled in GED. 13
- Number who enrolled in college. 67

OUTCOMES - The Self Sufficiency Continuum

- **38%** entered in the program in crisis or struggling and **EXITED AT ACHIEVING INDEPENDENCE.**
- **27%** entered the program in crisis or struggling and **EXITED AT STABLE.**
- **34%** entered in crisis or struggling and exited at **CONSISTENT PROGRESSION TOWARDS STABILITY.**
 - Less than 1% did not make any progress.

1. **45%** were unemployed and **obtained a job.**
2. **74%** increased their household income and reached the overall goal of the project.
